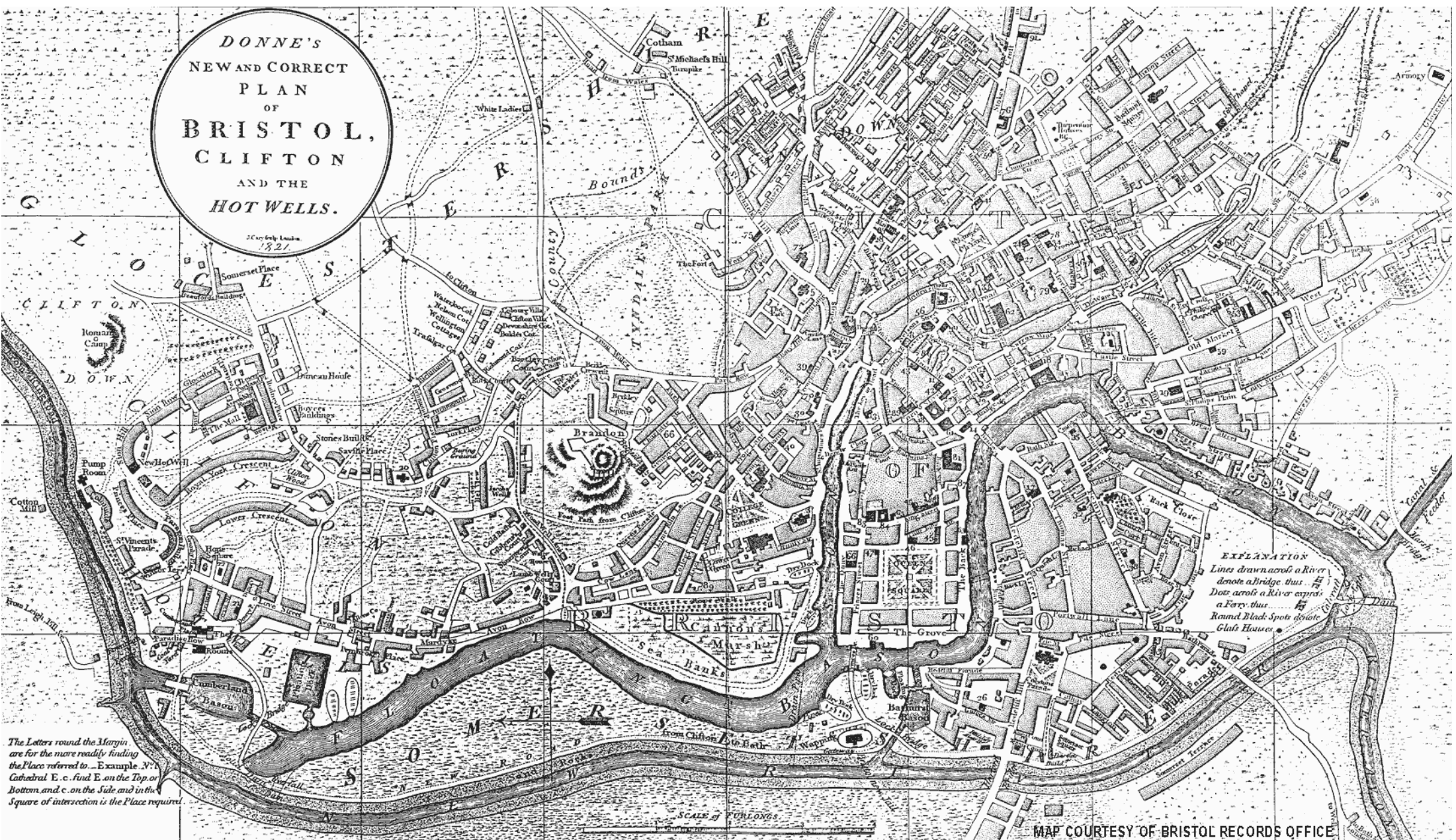


DONNE'S

Bottom, and c. on the Side and in the  
Square of intersection is the Place required.
